Pay Day

Your pay day with the LET will be the 28th of every month. Where the 28th falls on a weekend or public holiday you will receive payment on the working day preceding the 28th. Your payslip will be available via your ESR account 3-4 days in advance of pay day. August 2023 pay date will be Friday 25th August 2023. September 2023 pay date will be Thursday 28th September 2023.

Medical and Dental Pay Award 2023

The Government have announced a pay uplift for Medical and Dental Doctors and Dentists in postgraduate training. The full pay award details, the new pay circular and key information can be found on NHS Employers website. In summary Doctors and Dentists in postgraduate training will receive 6% pay award plus additional consolidated increase of £1,250 on each pay point.

The ESR system will be amended for this pay award to be calculated this weekend, once this is completed the LET will be working hard to ensure all backdated pay is paid in September salary. Manual calculations will be completed to amend any Parental Leave, Acting Up and Protection payments since 1st April 2023 and this will show in pay slips for September. Please note, the LET have paid Foundation Year 1 new starters Shadowing pay for July 2023 at the new pay award rate so no backdated pay will be due for these 5 days (26/7/23 – 1/8/23).

Claiming expenses

The LET use the EASY expenses system which is an electronic system to enable you to submit your claims and be paid timely for these expenses. Please use the following link to access the system https://let.easy.giltbyte.com. Using the system for the first time:

- Register with your payroll number.
- Ensure you have completed the 'Agreed nominated Base form' which can be found here and should be returned to nhc-tr.leteexpenses.ne@nhs.net
- Ensure you have registered and uploaded your vehicle documents, view the policy here for further details.

Your travel should be submitted on a monthly basis, the LET will pay any claims which are submitted and approved by 5th of each month. All claims must be submitted within 3 months of the travel in line with the <u>policy</u>.

Annual Leave

If you are new to employment with the LET you will have received an electronic Annual Leave card with your contract of employment. Please ensure you use this as you rotate around placements to track your Annual Leave usage. If you are a current employee of the LET and rotating please contact the LET on the above People Services email addresses with your used Annual Leave card and a new one will be issued to you.

Sickness Leave

Please ensure you are aware of your local placement policy to report your absence should you be unwell to attend work. The LET will receive regular reports from your placement of any absences and will update your ESR record with these. The LET will review any absences in line with our <u>Management of Attendance policy</u>.

Employee Staff Record (ESR)

Please ensure you have accessed your ESR record (username starts with 441) recently and reviewed your details. You must ensure your details are up to date including:

- personal details (address, phone number etc)
- your emergency contacts
- your e-learning record
- your ED&I information

Industrial Action

We know current situations with Industrial Action across the NHS is difficult and will be impacting you. The LET have a system in place whereby Host Training site confirm Industrial Action taken and the LET make the required deductions to employees salaries. Where you have been deducted salary and have not taken Industrial Action, please ensure you make contact with your local site HR and request they inform the LET of the error. The LET will take this instruction to amend your salary and pay any money owed.

Junior Doctor Forum

The LET run a Junior Doctor Forum on a quarterly bases and have a Guardian of Safe Working for all trainees who are not based within a Local Education Provider (Trust). This includes GP trainees based in Practice, Palliative Medicine trainees based in Hospices and Public Health trainees based in local authorities/other NHS providers.
